## **What is WooCommerce?**



## **How much does WooCommerce cost?**


Aside from Wordpress hosting fees, WooCommerce is entirely free!

1. Firstly, you will need a Wordpress site in order to set-up your WooCommerce store, you can begin by downloading the Bookvault plugin on Wordpress.



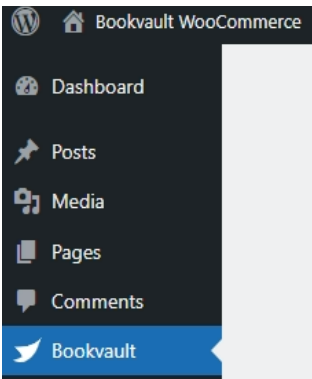

2. Then you will have to activate the plugin, with the same button.

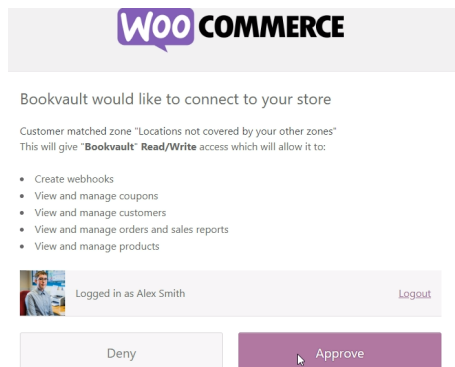

3. Bookvault will now appear on the left side of your Wordpress dashboard, click on this and you will be required to login or create an account.

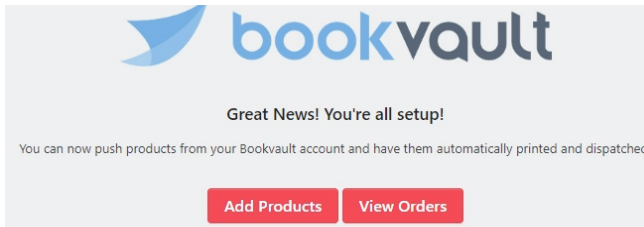


4. Once signed in, you will be prompted to approve Bookvault connecting to your store

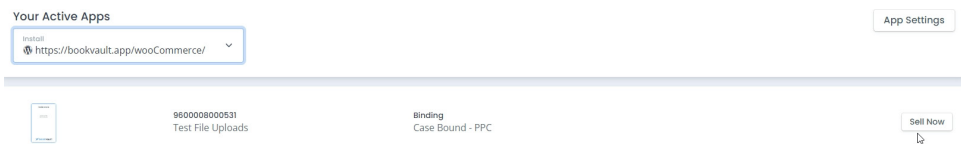




5. Now when you click on the Bookvault tab on your dashboard you will be able to add products, and view orders



6. Select titles from your books uploaded to Bookvault to sell, by pressing sell now, and subsequently selecting a price, and inserting a description. Remember, both of these factors will be important when trying to sell as many copies as possible!






7. Click 'Upload Now' and your book will be available for customers to purchase.
